Subject: Hodgetts Lane - Junction with Waste Lane & Nailcote Lane

Dear Sirs

I wish to advise you of proposed signing improvements to be undertaken at the junction of Hodgetts Lane/Waste Lane/Nailcote Lane.

Recent changes in guidelines from the Department for Transport have allowed the stipulations on the available visibility before "stop" signs can be introduced at junctions to be relaxed. The junction of Hodgetts Lane/Waste Lane/Nailcote Lane has had incidents occur which were due to "overshoot" type incidents from the Hodgetts Lane approaches. Therefore, it is proposed to change the Hodgetts Lane approaches from priority "give way" to "stop" to heighten a motorists awareness of the junction. I attach copies of drawing no.'s 8335/1 (sign locations & details) & the associated sign schedule showing the proposed scheme. "Stop" signs together with "stop" worded carriageway markings and "stop" lines will be introduced on Hodgetts Lane to emphasise the junction.
